...scholarship

Every year we invite nine female artists of all artistic fields to apply for a scholarship.

Requirements for the participation are a fine art degree and the achievement of the masterclass or a comparable qualification, as well as first professional experience. We ask autodidacts to provide a presentation of adequate practice. The age limit is 35 years and international artists are very welcome. The call is subject to the approved resources. After acceptance of the scholarship a continuous participation is mandatory.

Residency Program

The residency program includes a three months working space scholarship in the space of a room that... in the Spinnerei/Halle 14, Leipzig/Germany. The residents use the period for their free artistic process and have the opportunity to develop their entrepreneurial skills through a special coaching. The working period is followed by an exhibition. During the big gallery tours in the Spinnerei Leipzig the residents show their work at the same time as the other well-known galleries in the Spinnerei area to a broad and international audience.

Spring Session: February 15 – May 31

Summer Session: June 15 – September 30

The application must be postmarked on or before the deadline. In case this is a Saturday, Sunday or holiday, the following working day is effective.
